UNITED WAY OF HERNANDO COUNTY EMERGENCY ASSISTANCE SUCCESS STORIES



We met Chris out at the Ridge Manor Community Center. In passing, while picking up hot meals we were distributing and basic essentials (such as toilet paper and pillows) we learned that Chris and his wife have been kayaking their 3 year old and special needs brother to and from their home each day. Days after Milton, when the Withlacoochee River began to flood, he explained in detail the fear of slowly watching the water rise each hour, higher and higher overnight, reaching a total of 6 feet of brown water their home. As renters, their FEMA assistance options were limited and found themselves in desperate need of a habitable space. After assessing their needs on site, and managing to locate a trailer to rent, their next barrier was the first month's rent and deposit being due all at once in order to move in. With a landlord only willing to accept cash, our team swiftly connected with him onsite, vouching for payment and willing to cover expenses if this family could be placed in a dry home that night. Thanks to our flexible Disaster Relief Funding, we were safely able to rehouse this hard-working family who've unfortunately lost everything, but hope.

A single mother of a 12-year-old, who also serves as the primary caretaker for her disabled sister, found herself on the brink of having her electricity shut off. After recently separating from her spouse, she was suddenly faced with managing all household expenses on her own. Unsure of where to turn and feeling overwhelmed, she reached out to United Way—admitting that she didn't fully know what services we offered but hoped someone could help. United Way stepped in immediately to prevent her power from being disconnected, covering her electric bill to stabilize her household in the moment of crisis. Beyond emergency assistance, our team connected her with additional community supports, including Florida Master Money Mentors, to help her rebuild her financial footing and develop long-term stability. Thanks to United Way's guidance, she is now on a clearer path toward financial recovery. With one less urgent burden weighing her down, she can refocus her energy on what matters most—caring for her daughter, supporting her sister, and moving forward with renewed confidence.



A hardworking gentleman employed at a local distribution center found himself in a crisis after being evicted from his apartment. Although he maintained a steady, livable income, the eviction on his record made it nearly impossible to secure new housing. With nowhere else to go, he was forced to live out of his car. During this time, he shared that he hadn't been allowed to see his 3-year-old son due to his living situation. United Way was able to identify a unique opportunity: a former client had a room available for rent and was actively seeking a reliable tenant. United Way covered the deposit fee—allowing him to move into his new room that very same day. Later that evening, after sleeping in a real bed for the first time in weeks, he called to express his overwhelming gratitude. He shared how relieved he was to no longer be homeless and how excited he felt knowing he could finally see his son again. His story highlights the power of community, connection, and support at exactly the right moment.
