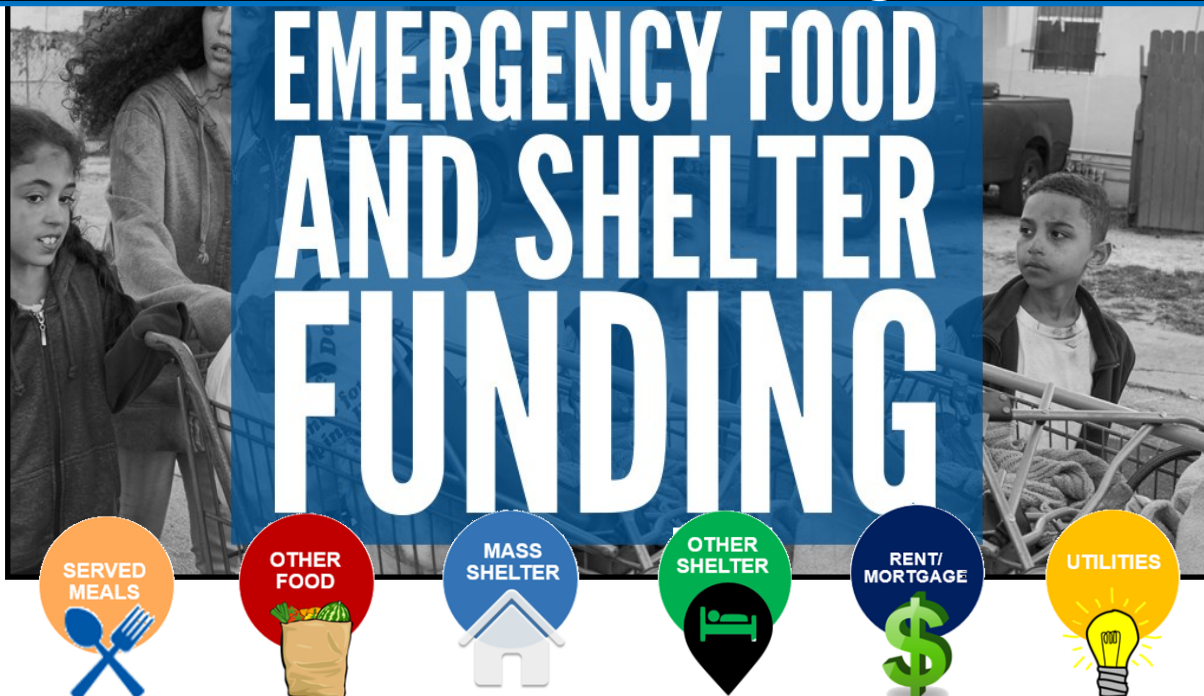


# HERNANDO COUNTY EFSP AGENCY WORKSHOP

In preparation for the **Phase 42** release, the Hernando EFSP Local Board has announced they will be conducting an educational & **mandatory virtual** workshop for agencies interested in applying for EFSP and submitting an application request.

## **VIRTUAL WALK-THRU, INSTRUCTIONS & GUIDANCE FOR POTENTIAL APPLICANTS**

### **ELIGIBLE APPLICANTS MUST:**

- ⇒ Be a 501(c)3 non-profit agency serving Hernando
- ⇒ Have at least a minimum of one year of operations, providing services in the field applying for
- ⇒ Have the ability to maintain and submit comprehensive reports with supporting backup documentation (including backdated reports)
- ⇒ Have the ability to operate on a reimbursable basis
- ⇒ Have a reliable accounting system
- ⇒ Practice non-discrimination

- ⇒ Help guide organizations interested in funding
- ⇒ Educate potential applicants on the ESFP application process
- ⇒ Provide guidance on how to properly record & report all needed documentation
- ⇒ Help applicants understand all state and local requirements
