MH in the USA (NIMH)

Mental Illnesses are common in the United States and around the world. It is estimated that:


- 1 in 5 US adults experience mental illness each year
- 1 in 20 experience a serious mental illness each year.
- 50% of all mental illness begins by age 14 and 75% by age 24.
- Suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death among people aged 10-14

Lifetime Prevalence of Any Mental Disorder Among Adolescents (2001–2004)





Suicide rates

According to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention in 2022:

- Suicide is a leading cause of Death in the United States. It was responsible for 49,449 deaths. (1 death every 11 minutes)
- Suicide rates are still significantly higher among males than females. Males accounted for 38,358 deaths and females accounted for 9,825.
- People ages 85 and older have the highest rates of suicide.

Substance Use and Mental Health Services

- **Office Based Counseling:** individual, family and group.
- **Psychiatric Medical Services:** evaluation & medication management. Medication Assisted Treatment (SUD)
- **Behavioral Health Consultant (BHC):** Case Management for substance abusing parent with DCF involvement.
- **Family Intensive Treatment Team (FITT):** intensive in-home treatment & wrap around services to child welfare involved, substance abusing families with child <10 yrs.
- **Mental Health Court:** on site clinician & case manager.
- **Drug Court:** on site clinician and group and Peer services.

Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services cont'd

Forensic Case Management: linkage, advocacy and monitoring, community restoration.

Mobile Response Team: Clinician, CM and Mentor respond to individuals experiencing a MH crisis. Safety plans if possible, follows for 30 days while linking to services.

FACT Team (New): Florida Assertive Community Team provides wrap around services to individuals with SPMI in an attempt to maintain gains and stay in community.

- **Supportive Living – SPMI Housing**
- **Prevention Services**
 - Wellness Recovery Action Planning
 - Active Parenting
 - Dawn Center
 - Park Outreach
- **Residential Co-Occurring Substance Abuse:**
Community Recovery Center 1.85 beds.
- **Detox:** Adult Treatment Center 2.0 beds.

Child Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services

- **Office Based Counseling:** individual, family and group.
- **In Home/On-Site Counseling:** school, home, etc. (TBOS)
- **Targeted Case Management:** linkage, advocacy and monitoring.
- **Psychiatric Medical Services:** evaluation and medication management.

CAT Team (Children's Assertive Team) : Provides intensive wrap around services in the highest level of care in the community in order to forestall home/community removal

Services Continued.....

- **Inpatient Psychiatric (Pasco ICSU)**
- **C.H.A.T. Community Health Activation Team**

Offers outreach & prevention services using focused on the 7 National Prevention Strategies. CHAT services include coping skills classes, screening and linkages to behavioral health services for priority populations, substance abuse prevention classes and community events, including Teen Court.

Classes include:

Botvin's Life Skills Curriculum, Project Alert, Project Toward No Drug Abuse, Creating Lasting Family Connections, Mental Health First Aid, Resiliency, Active Parenting, Catch My Breath, Positive Action
